

**Town of Clinton Ordinance #108**  
**ATV and UTV Amended 3/12/13**

**108 (1) Intent**

The Town Board of the Town of Clinton hereby adopts the following all-terrain vehicle and utility terrain vehicles ordinance and routes for the operation of all-terrain vehicles and utility terrain vehicles upon the roadways listed in Section III.

Following due consideration of the recreational value to connect trail opportunities and weighted against possible dangers, public health, liability aspects, terrain involved, traffic density and history of automobile traffic, the routes have been created.

**108 (2) Statutory Authority**

This route is created pursuant to Town authority as authorized by 23.33 (8) (b), Wis. Stats.

Further, Stat 23.33 (11) authorizes the Town to create ordinances to regulate ATV's and UTV's on trails or routes that are designated by the Town.

**108 (3) Routes**

This ordinance opens all town roads to ATV's and UTV's.

**108 (4) Conditions**

As a Condition for the use of this route, the following shall apply to all operators.

- A. All ATV's and UTV's must display current registration.
- B. Insurance.
- C. Speed limits: 30 MPH, except that State law restricts speed to 10 MPH within 100 feet of pedestrians and when within 150 feet of a dwelling.

**108 (5) Enforcement**

This ordinance shall be enforced by any law enforcement officer of the State of Wisconsin or County of Barron.

**108 (6) Penalties**

Wisconsin state all-terrain and utility terrain vehicle penalties as found in s. 23.33 (13) (a) Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

**108 (7) Severability**

The provision of the ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town of Clinton would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons circumstances shall not be deemed affected.

**108 (8) Effective Date**

This ordinance becomes effective the day after passage and publication as provided by law.

This ordinance shall take effect on the day after passage and posting as provided by law.
