Ordinance Authorizing Shifts for Election Inspectors

ORDINANCE - #119

The Town Board of the Town of Clinton, Barron County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

1. Authorization: Wisconsin State Statute 7.30(1) authorizes the appointment of election officials.
2. Purpose: To provide for the general welfare of the election workers by creating split shifts for election workers who are required to work thirteen hours due the mandates of the polls being open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.
3. General Provisions: The Town of Clinton hereby adopts the powers set forth in Wisconsin Statute 7.30(1)(a), whereby a municipal governing body may provide by ordinance for the selection of alternate officials or the selection of two or more sets of officials to work at different times on election day, and may permit the municipal clerk to establish different working hours for different officials assigned to the same polling place.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law.
